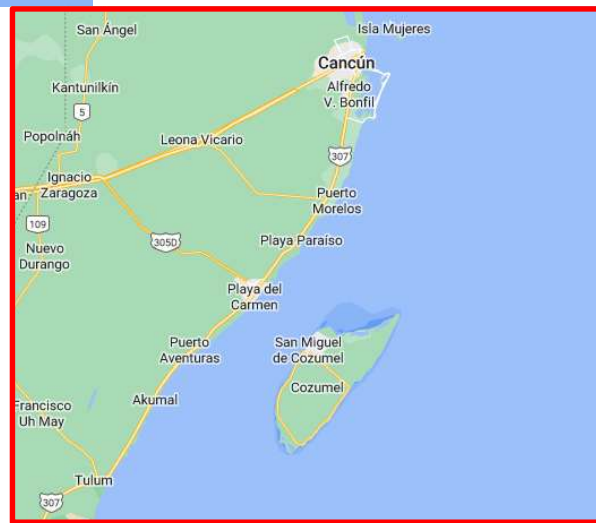
Attendant Trip Guide

We would appreciate that you could take a few minutes to read it carefully and let us know in case you find something unclear, so we can improve it by adding any missing information.

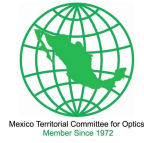
Cozumel Island

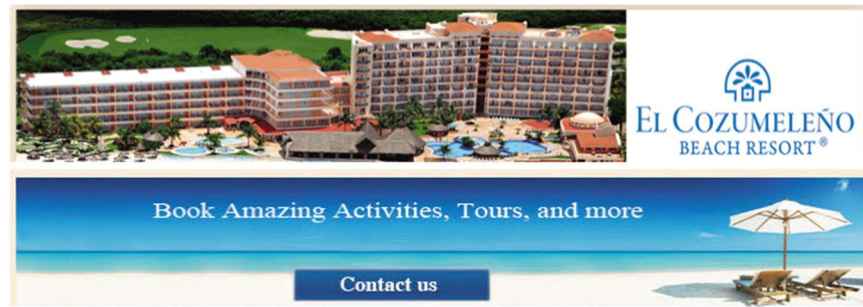

Please keep in mind that:

- [El Cozumeleño Beach Resort](#) does **not** provide shuttle or any other free transportation services, and
- You are **not** obliged to contract any transportation services, even though they claim they are offered by [El Cozumeleño Beach Resort](#).

If you are not staying at [El Cozumeleño Beach Resort](#), please remember that you will be asked to pay the USD 70.00 Day Pass per day, in order to enter the premises.

Landing in Cozumel (CZM)

The [Cozumel International Airport \(CZM\)](#) is located in the island, just 6.5 km away from the [El Cozumeleño Beach Resort](#).

The trip from the [Cozumel International Airport](#) to [El Cozumeleño Beach Resort](#) should take around 10 minutes and you can make it on a shared shuttle or by taxi, which you can book on site or in advance at the airport website: <https://airport-cozumel.com/>.

Landing in Cancun (CUN)

Important If you are entering Mexico at the [Cancun International Airport \(CUN\)](#), you may have to pay the [VisiTAX](#) in advance. [VisiTAX](#) can be paid to your earlier convenience at: <https://www.cancunairport.com/visitax.html>



The [Cancun International Airport \(CUN\)](#) is the second busiest one in Mexico and it has four terminals (T1, T2, T3 and T4). We highly recommend you that you clearly identify the one you will be landing on in advance.

Please **reject any unsolicited information, “help” or transportation services.**

There is a free-of-charge bus service running across all the four terminals. If you land in terminal T1, please use it to move to terminal T2, T3 or T4.

Bus from CUN to Playa del Carmen

Once you are in terminal T2, T3 or T4, look for the closest ADO Buses tickets kiosks located at the ground transportation areas of each terminal in order to travel to Playa del Carmen.



There are two bus terminals in Playa del Carmen, please make sure you are travelling to the Touristic Terminal. Check the bus schedules running from each [Cancun International Airport](#) terminal to the Playa del Carmen Touristic Terminal here:

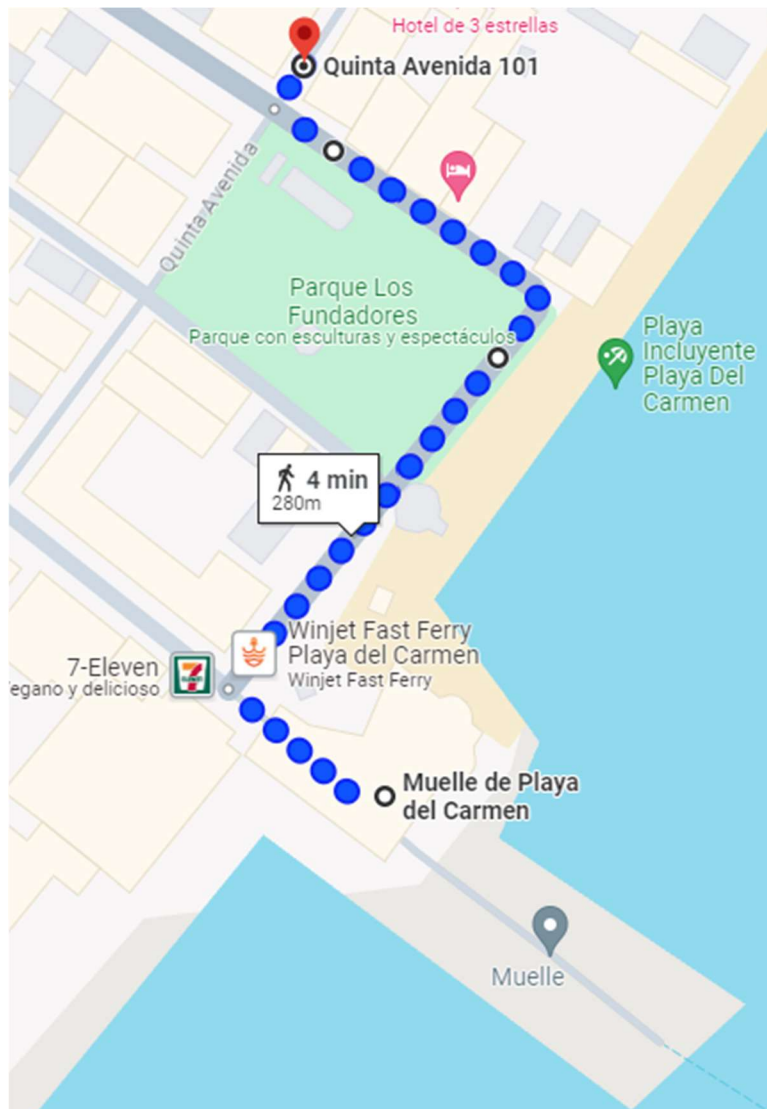

You can also buy your ADO bus tickets online in advance, but please do this only if you are absolutely sure about your flight arrival time, since they do not have refunds or changes.

Playa del Carmen is 57.2 km away from the [Cancun International Airport](#) and the trip from its terminals T2, T3 or T4 to the Touristic Terminal of Playa del Carmen takes about one hour.

Once you exit the Playa del Carmen Touristic Terminal, make it to the Playa del Carmen Ferry dock; located just 280 meters away. It will take you a 4-minute walk, as shown below.

Ferry from Playa del Carmen to Cozumel Island

Cozumel Island is 18.95 km across Playa del Carmen, and the trip by ferry takes between 35 minutes and 45 minutes.

There are three ferry companies sailing from the Playa del Carmen ferry dock to the Terminal Marítima Muelle San Miguel de Cozumel. You can check their schedules and prices here:

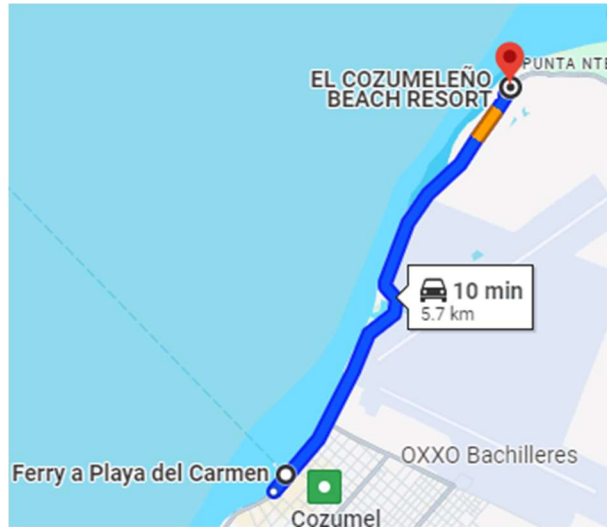

From the Cozumel ferry dock to El Cozumeleño Beach Resort

The Terminal Marítima Muelle San Miguel de Cozumel is 5.7 km away from [El Cozumeleño Beach Resort](#) and a car/bus/taxi/shuttle trip regularly takes around 10 minutes.



Once you exit the ferry dock you can take a local taxi, a shared shuttle or a local bus just across the street.

You can check the taxi fares here: <https://vivocozumel.com/guia-turistica/transporte-urbano-en-cozumel/taxi-en-cozumel/tarifas-muelle-san-miguel/>. All fares are shown in Mexican pesos (MXN), since the symbol \$ is also used for MXN.

Before boarding a taxi:

- Ask the driver for the fare of your specific trip.
- Is you are not paying in MXN, ask the driver for the exchange rate with your currency.
- Check the number of the taxi and take their company phone number.
- Check you are not leaving anything behind when you get off the taxi.
